2 Try our Challenge

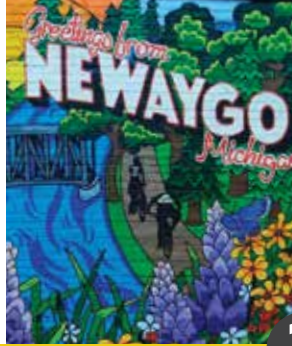

1 GO explore PUBLIC ART

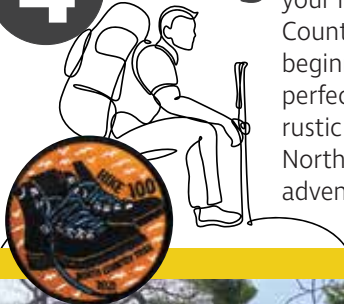

13+ miles of technical trails invite you to a new mountain biking experience: The Dragon. The initial trail segments include: 7 bridges, 3 overlooks, 100 feet of rock armoring, and 400 feet of wooden boardwalk, creating a trail that is both challenging and fun. Maybe you are looking for something a bit more leisurely? Try Fremont's Town & Country Path for a mostly paved experience for all age and ability bikers. With so many marked trails Newaygo County is a great place to spend a weekend of biking.

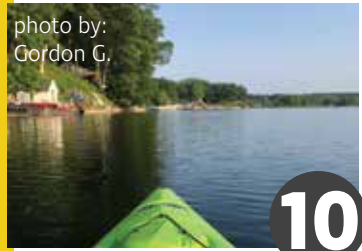

The Michigan Cross Country Cycle Trail in White Cloud offers over 16 miles to ride in Newaygo County, and connects to other regional trail systems. But the trails aren't the only place to ride, the roads of Newaygo County are also Off-Road Vehicle (ORV) friendly. ORV/ATVs are welcome on any of Newaygo County's maintained roads and at White Cloud County Park and Diamond Lake Park.
