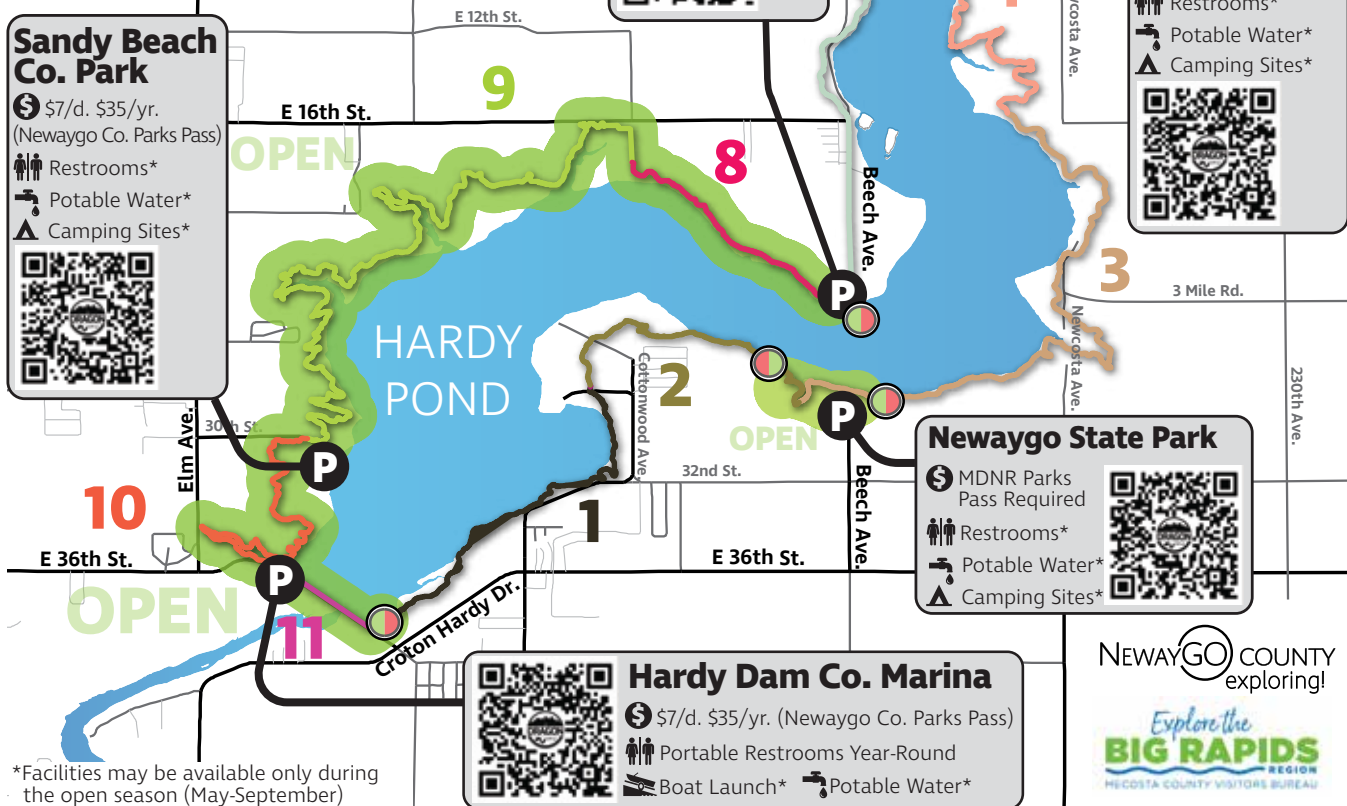

OPEN SEGMENTS

FULLY OPEN SEGMENTS

- 5.55 miles** starting at Polk Road in Stanwood and ending at 8 Mile Road
- 1.8 miles** from Big Bend Park to 16th Street in Big Prairie Township, Parking available at Big Bend Park.
- 7.4 miles** and starts from 16th Street in White Cloud, ending at 30th Street.
- 1.7 miles.** Park at the Hardy Marina trailhead.
- 0.7 miles.** paved shoulder of M-20/Elder
- 0.7 of a mile** connecting the west side of the trail system to the east. It runs on the paved roadway shoulder of 36th St.

PARTIALLY OPEN SEGMENTS

- Approximately **1.0 mile** is completed within the Newaygo State Park
- Approximately **1.5 miles** is completed making up the "Brower Loop" at the north end of the segment.
- Approximately **1.4 miles** of gravel road is open.
