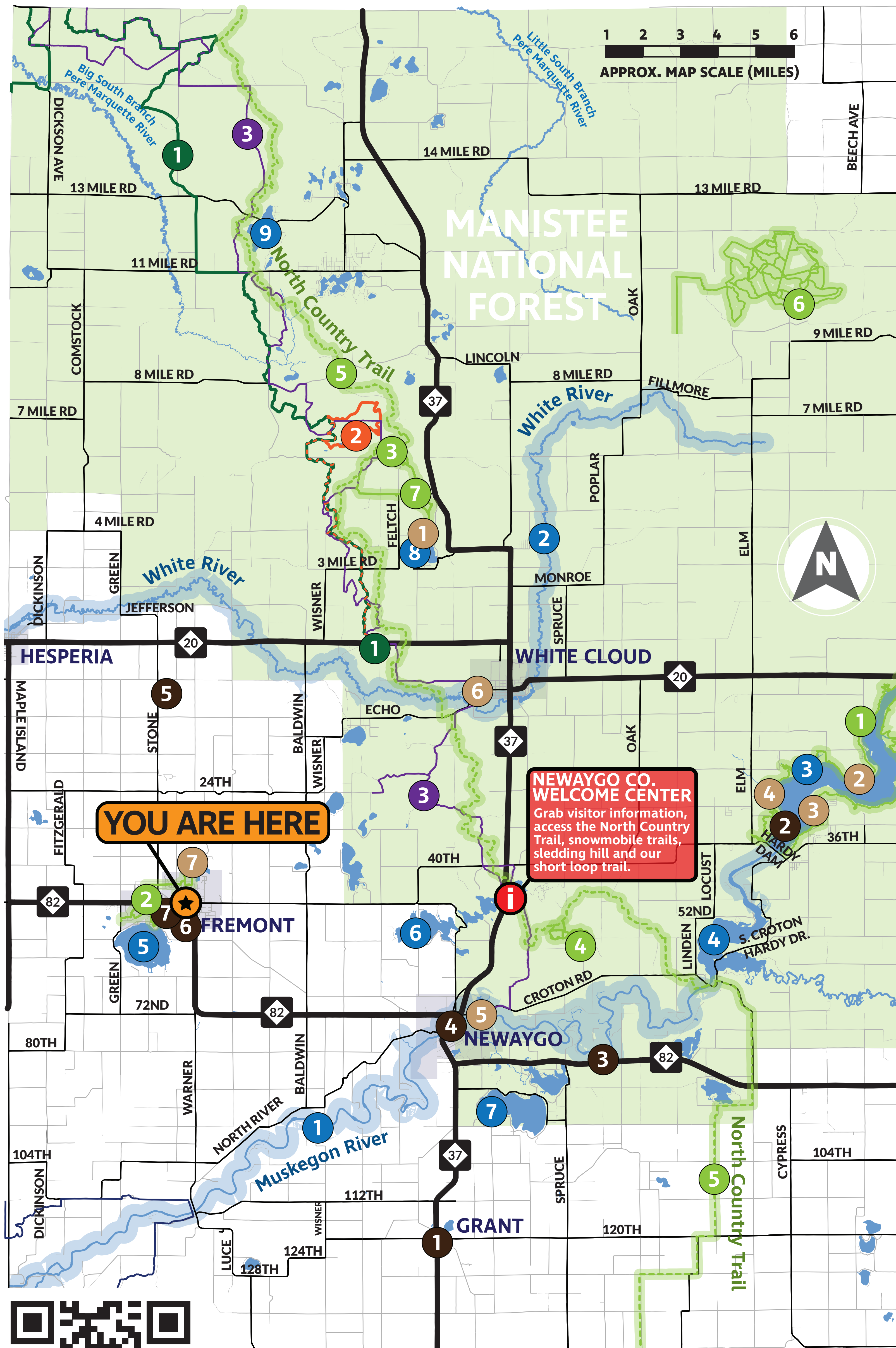

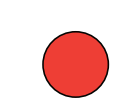

Fremont Town & Country Path

This 5+ mile paved non-motorized path takes you in and around the Fremont Community to some of the most beautiful areas of the community, north from Branstrom Park to Fremont Lake

Branstrom Park

Explore this 100+ acre park with a 2 mile loop trail, picnic area, pavilion, playground and 24-hole disc golf course. During the winter, enjoy a skating rink and trails for snowshoers and XC skiers.

Veterans Memorial

Located in the heart of town with a large playground, splash pad, memorial wall, and amphitheater that features many live performances throughout the season.

Dogwood

Center for the Performing Arts
The arts and cultural hub for Fremont featuring art, live performances and much more.

NCCA ArtsPlace

Enjoy exhibits, classes, artist markets and much more at this hub for art in the region.

Arboretum Park

Explore this 7 acre park devoted to the many and fine native Michigan trees, shrubs and wildflowers. A beautiful open space and walking path will allow you to explore the outdoor beauty of the region.

Skate Park

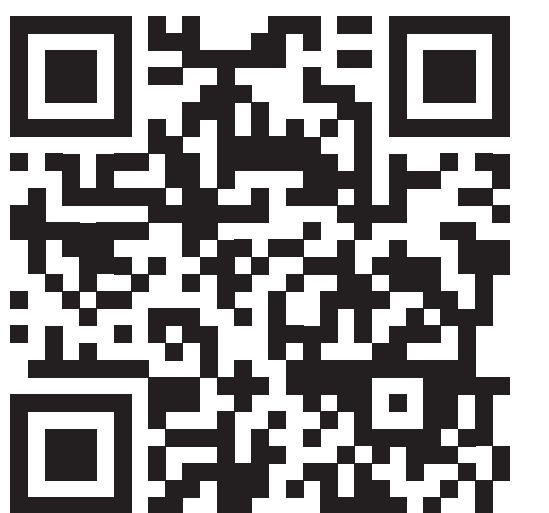
Dog Park
